Bible Memory Verse - Matthew 6:20-21

Store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

GOD GIVES THE COMMANDMENTS

Exodus 19:18-20; 20:1-21

My loving God gives direction!

God led His people, the Israelites, to a tall mountain called Mount Sinai. The people set up tents and gathered fuels to make fires to cook on. They found places for their animals to rest and eat.

The mountain was wrapped in smoke, because God had come down in the fire. The smoke rose into the sky and the mountain shook. God spoke to Moses in the thunder.

God told Moses to come to the top of the mountain. He wanted to talk to Moses. God told Moses many things while Moses was on the mountain. God gave Moses two stone tablets with the Ten Commandments. The Ten Commandments were rules for living a life that would be pleasing to God.

God said, "I am the Lord your God. You shall have no other gods before Me. You shall not bow down to idols, I am a jealous God. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain. Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy. Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's family or possessions."

Moses went down the mountain and told the people everything God had told him. He told them not to be afraid. God loved them very much and gave them the Ten Commandments so they would know how to live as His people.
